Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain moving eastwards across southern parts of England and Wales this morning. Elsewhere will be brighter, with sunny spells and a few showers with these falling as snow over the highest ground in the north. Feeling cold, with a brisk westerly wind. Showers will ease through the evening, with most places becoming clear and frosty overnight.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain will move eastwards during Tuesday, falling as snow across the high ground in the north. Brighter skies following, before further wet and windy weather moves into the southwest later. Staying very windy on Wednesday, with rain clearing to blustery showers.
