Headline:

Snow showers easing, then rain or sleet reaching the northwest.

Today:

In northern areas, snow showers should clear before rain or sleet in northwest Scotland moves southeastwards. Further south, snow showers will become confined to the extreme southeast.

Tonight:

Most southeastern areas will stay frosty, while other regions have rain or sleet after early frost in southern and central regions.

Outlook for Friday:

Bright in many areas, although some snow in the southeast at first.
