Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Wintry showers over northern Scotland persisting during the day, then largely dying out overnight as cloud increases. Elsewhere, showers, wintry on hills, developing inland, mainly eastern and central England, then dying out overnight. Winds fresh in places, particularly the northeast and southwest, decreasing later. Feeling chilly in wind, but pleasant in sheltered sunny spots. Widespread overnight frost.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Cloudy and quite windy over Scotland with outbreaks of rain, locally heavy in the west. The rain will spread south across Northern Ireland and northern England on Thursday. England and Wales dry, plenty of sunshine on Wednesday, more cloudy on Thursday.
