Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
After a potentially icy start over N.Ireland, any showers over England will soon clear to the southeast then most places will see some bright or sunny spells. Brisk northwesterly winds will gradually ease through the day. Cloud will thicken from the southwest later with some patchy rain in the evening.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain and strong winds will spread up the western side of Britain and N.Ireland on Thursday with some heavy rain over Scotland. Drier to the southeast. On Friday the rain should die out, and become largely confined to the far N of Scotland. Drier and milder, if rather cloudy elsewhere.
