Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A dry and frosty start across central and southern areas. However, cloudy skies will spread to all areas through the morning as outbreaks of rain push southeastwards. Wintry showers will then filter into the northwest. Heavy rain will push eastwards across the UK overnight, with bands of sleet and snow moving into the northwest.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain will clear the southeast through the morning, and it will turn drier and brighter for most places. However, wintry showers will pack into western and central parts. Turning wet and windy for many places on Saturday, with hill snow in the north.
