Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Many areas will have sunshine and slow-moving heavy showers today, some heavy with thunder. Northern and central Scotland will see some longer spells of rain, whilst cloud and persistent rain will cross southern counties of England. In-between all the rain and showers, some places should remain dry, and feeling warmer than of late. The rain or showers will mostly clear overnight, but lingering in central and eastern Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Monday and Tuesday see more sunshine and scattered showers, still locally heavy with thunder. Gradually, there will be fewer showers in the south, and in light winds, feeling warm in any sunshine.
