Westerly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later in north. northwesterly 2 or 3 in south and east at first
Slight, becoming moderate later in north

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast, backing north at times, 3 to 5, decreasing 2 at times, perhaps increasing 6 later mid channel.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate to rather rough later in the north of the area.

Isolated showers, becoming frequent, locally heavy this evening and tonight, perhaps thundery for a time later tonight, then fog patches and occasional drizzle.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor, becoming moderate to very poor for a time later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, perhaps 6 at first mid channel, decreasing 1 to 2 at times, becoming north to northwest by mid morning on Sunday, then variable 1 to 3 later in the far north of the area.

Moderate to rather rough at first in the north of the area, otherwise slight to moderate with a low swell developing.

Showers, frequent in the evening and overnight, locally heavy, perhaps thundery, fog banks for a time later.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor, becoming moderate to very poor for a time later.

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
