Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Northern Ireland, central and southern Scotland will have rain, while England and Wales will be hotter than yesterday. Although mostly dry, isolated showers are possible, mainly across eastern England later. Northern Scotland will be fresher with sunshine and scattered showers. Rain moving south overnight. Clearer with scattered showers elsewhere, showers perhaps heavy and thundery in the east.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday will be cooler with some heavy showers, especially in the southeast. However, still some warm sunshine in the south. Becoming drier and sunnier in the northwest. Sunny spells and scattered showers for most on Tuesday, cloud and rain in the southwest later.
