Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Scotland should be dry with sunny spells today, but feeling cool. Elsewhere, mainly dry and fairly warm with variable cloud and bright spells, just a little light rain in some places at first. A murky start though for many southwestern areas, but brightening-up here later. Staying dry and settled for most overnight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Mostly dry with variable cloud and sunny spells on Saturday, but cloud will thicken later for most central and southern parts with heavy rain arriving during the evening and overnight. The rain lingers through central and southern parts during Sunday, but remaining mostly dry and bright further north.
