Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloudy in many areas throughout, but periods of sunshine are likely in northern England, northwest Wales and eastern Scotland. There will be occasional light rain in northwest Scotland and some light rain or sleet also for central and southern England, with cold northeasterly winds in the south. Frost and patchy fog is likely where skies are clear overnight.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Outbreaks of rain for northwest Scotland on Wednesday, easing through the afternoon. Otherwise generally dry, with varying amounts of cloud but some welcome sunshine for southern England too. Staying rather cold with light winds, but breezy in the south at first.
