Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Apart from a little rain for northern Scotland, all areas will be dry with some hazy sunshine, once patchy fog in parts of the south clears. It will be windy in the north with strong gusts to the lee of hills.

Tonight, a little rain for northern Scotland, otherwise it will remain dry. However fog will become widespread and locally dense in the south by morning.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Fog in the south will only slowly clear, then most places will be dry with hazy sunshine. Many places will start dry on Tuesday, but outbreaks of rain will spread southeastwards, reaching all but southeast England by evening.
