Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rain, sleet and snow over south Wales, Midlands and Lincolnshire at first, moving southeastwards, clearing southeast England by mid afternoon. Widespread ice over northwestern Britain at first with snow over northeast Scotland. Scattered wintry showers over western Britain. Rain, with snow on northern edge, spreading east across southwestern Britain during the afternoon. Cold.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Frosty, foggy start for many on Wednesday, but rain, sleet and snow over southern parts of both England and Wales, clearing southwards, then many parts dry and sunny. Rain, snow and strong winds spreading east across all parts on Wednesday night and during Thursday, blustery showers following.
