Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Northeastern parts should again be dull and cold. Showery rain, which will be heavy at times and probably thundery, will spread northwards through the day and overnight. The best of the drier and brighter weather will be in the southeast and northwest, where it will be warm as well.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Another dull and drizzly day across the northeast on Thursday. Further showery rain in the west and southwest will gradually move northwards, with sunny spells in the southeast before some showers reach here later. The rain should clear the north early on Friday, with further heavy showers in the west.
