Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Any early morning fog patches will soon clear to leave a largely fine day with prolonged warm sunshine for many. However, it will be cloudier in the far north with some patchy rain. Turning cloudier across north-western areas overnight with some patchy light rain towards dawn. Chilly elsewhere under largely clear with some fog patches across England and Wales.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Plenty of sunshine for much of England and Wales on Sunday and turning very warm in places. Meanwhile, a weakening rainband will move south-eastwards across north-western areas with colder, showery conditions following. Monday will be noticeably colder with sunshine and showers.
