Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rather cloudy across many southern areas today, with occasional light rain or drizzle around western coasts and hills. It will turn increasingly wet across Northern Ireland and southern Scotland through the afternoon. Overnight, this band of rain will sink southeastwards across England and Wales, accompanied by gusty winds in places, and introduce much colder air.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Sunny spells and showers on Tuesday, the heaviest of which will be across parts of the Midlands, northwest England and Wales, where a risk of hail and thunder. More general rain on Wednesday, especially across central areas of the UK. Feeling much cooler than recently.
