

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
There will be further outbreaks of rain in northwestern Scotland along with strong winds. Cloud will increase from the northwest elsewhere with occasional drizzle around coasts and hills in the west. Some warm sunshine is likely in southeastern areas of England but it will stay generally breezy. Rain may turn heavy at times overnight in northern Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Northwestern parts of the UK are likely to stay mostly cloudy with outbreaks of rain at times. It will be drier with some sunshine in the south and east. Temperatures will remain around or a little above average, and it will be breezy.
