Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many places will have another dull, overcast day. It should also be dry for most, despite all the cloud, but drizzle is possible in a few places. Some sunshine will occur across northeastern Scotland and parts of Cornwall for a time. Feeling chilly in many places. Remaining mainly cloudy overnight with a little drizzle in places. Frosty across northeastern Scotland.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Some mainly light rain or showers are expected on Wednesday away from eastern districts. The rain will still affect some parts of northern England, Scotland and Northern Ireland for a time on Thursday but elsewhere it should be dry.
