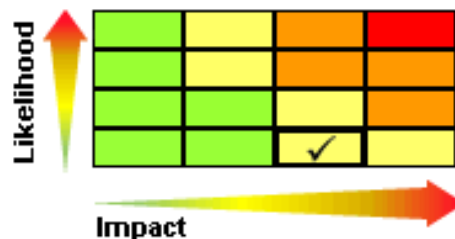
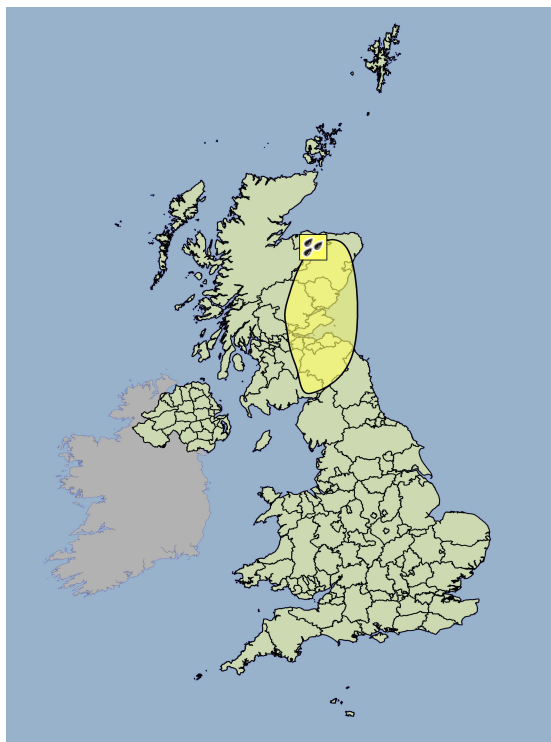




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A moist and increasingly unstable airmass will affect Scotland today with the likelihood of some heavy, thundery showers breaking out this afternoon and evening. These have potential to produce some large rainfall totals in a short space of time, leading to localised surface water flooding, whilst other nearby locations see very little.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **15:00 on Fri, 08th Aug 2014** until **23:00 on Fri, 08th Aug 2014**

Heavy showers will develop across southeastern Scotland this afternoon and extend northwards into the northeast by evening, leading to some localised heavy, thundery downpours.

The public should be aware of the risk of localised flooding and possible disruption to transport.
