



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment
 A frontal zone will continue to affect Wales at times today, bringing prolonged spells of heavy rain to the warning area. With strong winds and moist air this is likely to generate some large rainfall accumulations. Rainfall could exceed 40 mm in places.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **11:30 on Thu, 03rd Dec 2015** until **21:00 on Thu, 03rd Dec 2015**

Further prolonged spells of heavy rain are expected across northern parts of Wales through the day. Given saturated ground and high river levels, be aware of the potential for flooding, leading to disruption to travel, localised property flooding and danger from fast-flowing deep water.

This is an update to reduce the size of the yellow area, confining the warning to northern parts of Wales. This is because any further spells of heavy rain across southern Wales today are expected to short lived.
