Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Outbreaks of rain in Scotland and Northern Ireland will clear from the northwest, with all parts dry before evening, though with isolated showers in northern Scotland later. North Wales and northern England will cloud over, with patchy rain in the afternoon. Elsewhere should be dry and very warm with sunny spells after any early mist clears.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday, isolated showers in northern Scotland. Cloudy over southern England at first, with patchy drizzle, becoming brighter and sunnier from the north. Feeling fresher. Tuesday, all places starting dry, then rain and freshening winds spreading over Scotland and Northern Ireland from northwest.
