Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0600 UTC Monday 02 November to 0600 UTC Tuesday 03 November 2015

General Situation

High pressure centred over the Continent will bring settled conditions to the British Isles during the next 24 hours, although areas of fog over the land may drift offshore to affect some coastal waters at times.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Sutherland and Orkney, becoming variable 3 at times elsewhere.

Moderate or rough to west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly south 3 or 4, but southwest 5 or 6 at first near Cape Wrath.

Mainly slight, but moderate occasionally rough to west and north of Orkney.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 at times in south.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Fog patches in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, then becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Fog patches, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 at times.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight.

Fog patches, rain later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4.

Slight.

Fog patches, showers later.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fog patches, showers later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, veering southeast later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then showers.

Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate in west, but becoming rough later near the Isles of Scilly.

Fog patches at first in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East veering southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then veering west later.

Rough at first near the Isles of Scilly, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain for a time.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south, becoming variable 2 at times in north.

Slight, occasionally moderate in far south.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in far south.

Fair then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally variable 2 at first, then increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in northwest.

Fog patches at first, rain later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally variable 2 at first, then increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then backing northeast later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fog patches, rain later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 at times in south.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near the Mull of Kintyre, then

becoming variable 3 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Fog patches at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in North Channel, then backing northeasterly later.
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.
Rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.
Slight or moderate in south, moderate or rough in north.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable 3 or less.
Slight or moderate in south, moderate or rough in north.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in north, decreasing 4 at times in south.
Slight or moderate.
Drizzle at times.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then becoming variable 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Drizzle at times, mainly in north.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in north, decreasing 4 at times in south.
Moderate or rough.
Drizzle at times.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then becoming variable 3 or 4.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.
Drizzle at times.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Pressure remains high over the North Sea while a low complex is slow moving near

Iceland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: southwesterly gale force 8 continuing, issued at 01/0334 UTC

Southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in northwest and 4 later in southeast.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in northwest and slight later in east.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 02 Nov until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 03 Nov:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, but 4 in southeast.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in east.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East to southeast 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 this evening.

Slight, occasionally moderate later tonight.

Some mist patches this morning isolated showers later tonight.

Good, locally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4, occasionally 5, veering west decreasing 3 to 4 overnight.

Slight to moderate.

Isolated showers, most likely at first and again overnight.

Good, occasionally moderate.

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
