Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Fog patches slowly clearing through Monday, however, it will be dry and bright for many with light winds. Turning cloudier in the north and west and becoming windy in the far northwest. Cold and frosty overnight for much of England and Wales, away from the west, with fog/low cloud probably becoming widespread. Cloudier, milder and windier in the north.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Fog and low cloud slowly clearing on Tuesday. Cloudy, windy and mild conditions with some rain/drizzle in the northwest struggling to reach the southeast. Turning drier, brighter and cooler in the north through Wednesday, cloudy and mild with patchy rain elsewhere.
