

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Mainly fine with sunshine after a frosty start. Early ice patches may affect northwestern UK after overnight showers, with showers continuing to move in on the breeze here. Becoming increasingly cloudy in the far west later on, ahead of wet, windy weather spreading into northern and western UK overnight, while the south and east should stay dry with clear spells.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Generally windy on Monday, with occasionally heavy rain gradually moving from the northwest to the southeast, with showers following, although the far southeast may remain dry throughout. Remaining unsettled and windy on Tuesday, with most seeing further rain at times.
