Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A dry and bright day for most places, apart from isolated, mainly light, showers, these becoming confined to the far northeast later. Still windy in the northeast too, but winds easing elsewhere. Chilly overnight in England and Wales with local grass frost, but becoming cloudier with outbreaks of rain elsewhere.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Much of England and Wales starting sunny on Saturday but clouding over later with occasional rain or drizzle in the west and north. Northern Ireland and Scotland cloudier throughout with rain at times. On Sunday, many places cloudy with occasional rain, but driest in the far north and far south.
