Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Frosty start. Many places dry with sunny intervals and scattered wintry showers mostly across Scotland and Northern Ireland and coastal districts of England and Wales, a few spreading inland. Feeling very cold in fresh northwesterly wind. Overnight frosts returning during the evening.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Sunny intervals in the north and east on Sunday, but rain will spread eastwards, preceded by snow in northeast Wales and northern and central areas of England. Remaining cold and unsettled on Monday with wintry showers in northern areas, and rain spreading across southernmost counties of England, turning to sleet or snow as it spreads eastwards. Becoming windy.
