Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Some bright spells initially, but heavy showers in southern and western areas will become widespread and heavy with hail and thunder likely and possibly some localised flooding. However, southeast England and the far northwest will be somewhat drier. The showers may continue into this evening and also affect southeast England, but many places should then become drier with patchy fog.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Scattered heavy showers will develop once again on Monday, particularly widespread in eastern Britain, where locally slow-moving and thundery, but more isolated in the west. Tuesday will see scattered showers in northern Britain, with rain spreading east across southern areas.
