

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
There will be some locally very heavy rain across parts of southeastern Scotland, northern England and southeastern England this morning. Otherwise it will be a day of bright or sunny intervals and scattered heavy showers with a risk of thunder. Tonight showers will become increasingly isolated with most central and southern areas gradually becoming dry.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

On Tuesday there will be sunny intervals and scattered showers, the showers again heavy in the north but lighter and more isolated than of late in the south. Heavy rain will move northeastwards across England and Wales on Wednesday but the north will be drier.
