Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
There will be sunny spells for most today, accompanied by isolated showers for some. Meanwhile, a band of rain will inch its way across Scotland and Northern Ireland later. Showery rain will continue to move eastwards across the UK overnight, reaching parts of southeast England by dawn. Elsewhere, there will be occasional showers, especially in northern and western parts.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday will be largely dry with some sunshine. However, northwestern parts will see increasingly cloudy skies during the afternoon, with rain likely later. Cloudy and wet at times in the north on Saturday. Drier and brighter further south, though turning humid.
