

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Wet and very windy in northern and especially northwestern UK, with gales or severe gales potentially leading to disruption. Elsewhere, it will be windy but brighter, with blustery showers, especially for western and far southern UK. Remaining generally windy overnight, with spells of rain and some northern hill snow. It will be clearer further south and east, with fewer showers.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Mainly cloudy and unsettled on Thursday, with spells of rain chiefly affecting the north and west, and with northern hill snow. Friday will start mainly dry and frosty, particularly in the east, with rain spreading in from the west later.
