at 1945 on Monday 21 Jan 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Cold and frosty at first tomorrow, particularly in the east, with some  
widespread ice on any untreated roads. Sunshine will gradually be replaced by  
cloud and rain from the west during the day, although it will stay fine in the  
east much of the time.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

It will be mild and breezy on Wednesday, the rain heaviest in the north, only  
small amounts in the southeast. Thursday sees a mixture of sunshine and showers,  
the showers turning increasingly wintry in the north and west. The southeast of  
Britain will again be mostly dry.
