Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
The eastern side of Scotland and northeastern parts of England will have a spell of rain for a time on Saturday. Elsewhere there will be a scattering of showers, although some places will remain dry throughout the day. Most areas will have some sunny intervals, the best of which will develop in the south.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Most places will be dry all day on Sunday with sunny intervals and just a light breeze. On Monday there will be a little rain in western Scotland but England, Wales, Northern Ireland and eastern Scotland will be mainly dry, albeit rather cloudy.
