Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be largely dry with variable cloud and some warm sunny spells, the best of these in the morning. However, isolated showers are possible across Scotland and Northern Ireland. It will stay mostly dry overnight with a few showers in western parts of the country. Showers or rain may also develop across eastern and southeastern England towards dawn.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Heavy, showery rain is expected across northern England on Saturday morning, gradually moving northwards into southern and eastern Scotland. Sunshine and scattered showers are likely elsewhere. Further heavy showers are in store for Sunday, particularly in the north and west.
