Headline:

Cold in the north tonight. Showery rain spreading northwards Tuesday.

This Evening and Tonight:

Central and northern areas mostly dry, clear and cold with local frost and patchy fog. Southern areas, cloudier and milder. Some showery rain later.

Tuesday:

Chilly, sunny start in the north, but cloud and showery rain across southern areas spreading northwards, becoming locally heavy. Southern, then central areas becoming warm.

Outlook for Wednesday:

Rather cloudy with showery rain spreading northeastwards, locally heavy and thundery
