

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
The overnight rain across England and Wales will clear eastwards leaving a mainly dry and often sunny day. However isolated sharp showers are possible. A band of rain, heavy at times, then spreads eastwards during the night, bringing the risk of localised flooding. Winds also strengthen with gales in the south, turning severe along southwestern coasts.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain clears eastwards early on Saturday, leaving a day of blustery heavy showers, with hail and thunder at times. Winds will strengthen further, bringing potentially disruptive widespread gales to the south, locally storm force over southwestern coasts. Staying windy Sunday, with further showers.
