

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Persistent rain across eastern Scotland. Elsewhere, warmer than Tuesday with a chance of showers across most parts, these showers are likely to be heavy and perhaps thundery at times particularly during the morning. Tonight, rain will gradually extend across the south while the rain in Scotland will become confined to the far northeast. Most other areas will remain dry.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

It will be windy, rather cool and unsettled with gales likely along southern coasts. There will be some prolonged spells of rain which will turn heavy at times, especially on Thursday. Perhaps some bright spells in the south during Friday afternoon.
