

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Monday 27 Oct 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy rain and strong winds will continue across western and northwestern Scotland. It will be mostly dry and cloudy elsewhere, although patchy drizzle is expected across western parts of England and Wales. To the southeast it will be much brighter, and feel warm in places. Little change is expected overnight with the northwest of the UK staying very wet.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain, often heavy, will move southwards on Tuesday, reaching northern England and Wales by the evening. Brighter, colder weather will follow but it will stay warm with sunny intervals across southern Britain. However, patchy rain will affect the south on Wednesday.
