Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Blustery sleet or snow showers likely over eastern parts, with isolated showers perhaps developing elsewhere. Otherwise a generally dry, sunny and rather cold day is expected, with brisk northerly winds easing. Northwest Scotland will become cloudy, with a little rain this evening and tonight.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Becoming cloudy from the west during Wednesday, with some rain across Scotland, and patchy, light rain or drizzle over some other northern and western parts. Thursday will be mostly dry but cloudy over most of England and Wales, whilst much of Scotland will have rain, with rain spreading to Wales and northwest England in the evening.
