

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Brighter than on Tuesday with sunshine and scattered heavy showers and a risk of thunder. Cloudier across the south, but becoming brighter later. Southwesterly winds will gradually ease later. Overnight, clear spells and isolated sharp showers, mainly near southern and western coasts where it will be breezy. Inland, long clear spells will lead to a chilly night.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

A bright start for many Thursday, then showers will develop though not as frequent as on Wednesday and focussed in the north and west. Clouding over in the southwest later. Friday, rain in the south, perhaps heavy, brighter in the north with showers.
