

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 01 Mar 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Gales, severe in the northeast, but winds gradually easing. Sunshine and blustery showers, heaviest and increasingly wintry in northwest. A spell of heavy, squally rain moving across southern/central parts later with snow possible on northern edge. Breezy overnight, further wintry showers in the north and west with snow over hills and even to lower levels, bringing an ice risk.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Windy with possible local gales Monday. Sunny spells and wintry showers, heaviest and most frequent in the north and west with a local thunder risk. Significant snow accumulations over northern hills. Remaining cold and windy with further wintry showers on Tuesday.
