Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England will have a mainly dry day with sunny spells. Further south it will be cool and cloudy with outbreaks of mainly light rain. The rain will become confined to the far south overnight with most other parts being dry.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Outbreaks of light rain in the far south will clear during Sunday morning. All parts will then have sunny spells with a few showers. Further sunshine and showers are expected on Monday, with the showers heavy at times and falling as snow over Scottish mountains.
