

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Wednesday 01 Dec 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A very cold start in Scotland with some extremely low overnight temperatures, and widespread ice on untreated surfaces. Further snow showers are likely in eastern areas, spreading to some central areas. More persistent snow will fall in parts of southeast England, the best of any brightness further west. Northeasterly winds easing, but it remains bitterly cold.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Drier and sunnier across much of the UK on Friday, occasional snow showers around coasts, but widespread snow for Northern Ireland. Rain, sleet and snow is then likely to push into western parts on Saturday where it will slowly become less cold.
