Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
After a frosty start in places, most of the UK will be dry with light winds, sunny spells and a few showers. Showers will be most frequent across Scotland where hill snow is likely. However, it will become cloudy across western parts in the afternoon and outbreaks of rain will clip the far southwest of England.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Outbreaks of rain and brisk winds will spread across the northwest of the UK on Wednesday but it should be fine and dry elsewhere, and generally mild. Rain will continue slowly southwards on Thursday with only the far southeast holding onto some brightness.
