Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mostly a dry start. Any mist and low cloud across southern areas will lift leaving sunny spells and scattered cloud. Rain already in the far west will move northeastwards affecting most of the country by the end of the day, however southeast England should remain dry and see the best of any sunshine. Drier conditions should reach the southwest later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Sunshine and blustery showers on Tuesday, some heavy with risk of thunder, and longer spells of rain across western Scotland. More prolonged rain and strong winds will spread northeastwards overnight followed by sunshine and showers on Wednesday. Temperatures near average.
