

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Much of the country will have a dry day, despite rather a lot of cloud. There will, however, be a little drizzle across parts of northern England and southern Scotland initially, and more persistent rain is expected to reach Northern Ireland during the afternoon. Light winds, so feeling pleasant enough. Rain, heavy in places, will spread to most places overnight.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

A band of heavy, persistent rain will cross most parts during Tuesday. Mainly dry, much brighter weather should follow from the west, reaching all but eastern England by Tuesday evening. Most places dry on Wednesday with some bright spells.
