Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Blustery showers are expected to affect northern and western parts of the UK but it will be drier and brighter elsewhere. Winds will be lighter but still quite strong, with local gales across the northern half of the country. Showers should ease overnight and winds will weaken but it will be quite chilly with grass frost in places.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Much of England and Wales should remain dry and bright on Wednesday, but another spell of wet and windy weather is expected to spread across Scotland and Northern Ireland. This will continue through Thursday with only southeast England staying dry.
