Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
There will be sunny intervals and scattered heavy showers today, although some central and eastern areas will remain dry. However, persistent, heavy rain will gradually move eastwards across northern Scotland and gale force northerly winds will affect some exposed northwestern areas. Tonight, remaining windy with further showers or longer spells of rain for many.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday, showers or longer spells of rain in the east. In the west, sunny spells and only isolated showers, with many places remaining dry. It will be cold and windy with snow on northern hills. Rain will spread to all parts on Saturday.
