

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Saturday 10 Sep 2016

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain will linger across southeast Britain for much of the day. Elsewhere, plenty of sunshine, but blustery showers will affect western Scotland, with the odd one for Northern Ireland too. The rain across the southeast should finally clear by late evening and then with many places seeing clear conditions overnight, it will turn chilly.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Sunday will start sunny for most, albeit rather chilly. Cloud will tend to increase through the day, especially further west, where a strengthening southerly wind will introduce rain later. Wet and windy in the west on Monday, but turning warmer in the sunshine further east.
