Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Thursday 05 June to 0600 UTC Friday 06 June 2014

#### General Situation

An area of low pressure, lying across northern areas of the United Kingdom, will move slowly away northwards. A temporary ridge of high pressure will follow. Thundery troughs will then spread from the southwest later on Friday and into Saturday morning.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northeast, becoming variable later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, but moderate for a time near Orkney.

Rain and drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming east or southeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later near Cape Wrath.

Fog patches, drizzle at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Northeast, becoming variable, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first near Rattray Head.

Slight.

Occasional rain and drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming southeast, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, drizzle at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming west, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Slight.

Showers, rain for a time.

Moderate becoming good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest, backing southeast, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming west, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate for a time near headlands.

Showers for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West, backing southeast, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in south, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming easterly or southeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, then backing easterly 4 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly 4 or 5.

Slight.

Fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West, backing east, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Moderate becoming slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers later.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West, backing east, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in far west.

Showers then fair, thundery rain later in far west.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 6, decreasing 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West, backing east, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, thundery later in west.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 6, decreasing 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Westerly, backing easterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first in north, increasing 6 at times near St Davids Head.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in north.  
Showers, thundery rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West or northwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, then backing southeast later.  
Moderate, becoming smooth or slight.  
Showers then fair, occasional rain at first.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.  
Showers, thundery rain later.  
Good, occasionally poor later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwest 5 or 6, backing west 4 or 5, then backing southeast 3 or 4 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain then fair.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.  
Slight becoming moderate.  
Rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight, but moderate for a time in north.  
Showers then fair, rain for a time.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast 4 or 5.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.  
Showers then thundery rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later.  
Showers then fair, rain for a time.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming easterly 4 or 5.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.  
Showers, thundery rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate, becoming slight later.  
Rain or showers then fair.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable, becoming east, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate later.  
Thundery showers later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

The Minch  
24 hour forecast:  
North, veering northeast, 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in far south.  
Showers, rain for a time.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable, becoming east or northeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers.  
Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath  
24 hour forecast:  
North, veering northeast, 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate, occasionally slight at first.  
Showers, rain for a time.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable, becoming east or northeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
A complex low centred over the UK drifts east over the North Sea today, bringing an easterly flow to Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Northeast 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Thursday 05 Jun until 0600 UTC on Friday

06 Jun:

Northeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Mist or fog patches later.

Good, occasionally poor or very poor later.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 2 to 4, locally variable 1 to 3 south of jersey around midday, backing southeast to east in the afternoon, increasing 4 to 5 late evening.

Smooth or slight, locally moderate at first and again later.

Fair to cloudy slight risk of a shower later.

Good except in any showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 to 5, perhaps locally 6 mid-channel around midday, veering southerly and decreasing 2 to 3 late evening.

Slight, locally moderate in the north and west at first.

Scattered showers developing Friday night risk of thunder and mist patches.

Good, locally moderate to poor later.

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
