

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Monday 07 Sep 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain over some southern parts dying out during the morning, with only isolated afternoon showers. Most parts will have an entirely dry day, with sunny spells developing more widely by afternoon, except over some southern parts. Becoming cloudier in Northern Ireland and Scotland in the afternoon, with rain in the evening.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Wet and very windy in the northwest Tuesday, with a likelihood of severe gales and very heavy rain in some parts of western Scotland. It will stay dry, bright and warm in the south and east. Most of the UK will then be dry with sunny periods on Wednesday.
