Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rain will gradually clear from northeast Scotland, with scattered showers following. Elsewhere sunny intervals and scattered showers, once early rain clears from southeast England, some of the showers becoming heavy at times across eastern England. Feeling rather cool in places.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

A ridge of high pressure builds across the UK on Sunday with sunny spells in most places and only a few isolated showers, but still feeling rather cool. Cloud will thicken from the west on Monday with outbreaks of rain and drizzle spreading eastwards across the country, though southern parts will probably stay dry.
